### 1. What is the departure/drop off location?

Open Word Christian Ministries front parking lot, 6230 Hwy 92, Fairburn, GA 30213

Chaperones who wish to leave their cars should park in the second row directly in front of the church. We will be traveling on a Chartered 56 passenger coach.

### 2. What hotel will we be lodging?
